A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING A JUNIOR COMMISSION CIVICS EDUCATION PROGRAM.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners recognizes that community engagement and civic education is vitally important to a healthy republic and functioning democracy; and

WHEREAS, actively involving Charlotte County youth in understanding their local government can lead to a more engaged and informed citizen; and

WHEREAS, participating in a youth leadership program can promote experiential learning of the functions of government, develop healthy citizenry habits, and promote public awareness of the strengths and abilities of youth; and

WHEREAS, an annual youth civics program is to be provided to the public and open to participants who are senior students enrolled full-time in a public, private, or accredited home school program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County hereby establishes an annual Junior Commission Civics Education Program to promote civic engagement among area youth with all corresponding details to be outlined and promoted by the Charlotte County Commissioners and the Commission Office Staff.


