SEPTEMBER 12, 2017

A Special Meeting was held at the Murdock Administration Complex in Commission Chambers; Room 119, Port Charlotte, Florida.

The following members were present: Chair Truex, Commissioner Constance, Commissioner Deutsch, Commissioner Doherty, and Commissioner Tiseo. Also in attendance were: County Administrator Sandrock, County Attorney Knowlton, Clerk of the Circuit Court Eaton, and Commission Minutes Manager DiBerardino. The Meeting was called to order at 9:00 am, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Truex gave a brief overview of the Meeting.


Gerard Mallet, Emergency Management Director thanked Board and Staff, mentioned Charlotte County problems, timeline of events, post storm efforts, requested Declaration be extended, and responded to Board direction.

Chair Truex commented on storm conditions, roadway analysis, flood water levels, Manasota Key erosion, Declaration extension, and Emergency Operation Center (EOC). Commissioner Constance discussed storm conditions, Staff response times, road safety, fuel inventory, Florida Association of Counties (FAC) Policy Meeting, other counties, and Emergency Operation Center (EOC). Commissioner Doherty mentioned Staff organization, road safety, and flooding issues. Commissioner Deutsch spoke to Staff cooperation, citizen resilience, gas stations, and volunteers. Commissioner Tiseo thanked essential retail service workers, conversed about staff exemplary work, recovery, power grid, and fuel.
