

**Little Gasparilla Island Advisory Committee Meeting
November 12, 2010 – Minutes**

The meeting was held at Cedar Point Center at 1:00 and a quorum was present with only Carey Baychok and Carolyn Dupree not in attendance. Minutes of the July meeting were approved, and the committee then heard a report from Bob Hill and the Dock Sub-committee.

This committee met with DEP and representatives of Charlotte County on July 9. The discussion focused on the ownership of 5 community docks at the end of island streets. They are not in compliance with DEP regulations, and the county denied ownership of anything on the island. DEP cancelled a follow-up meeting until this ownership issue is resolved. Bob Hill will try to schedule another meeting with DEP on December 9.

Chuck Soderquist then reported on Fire Department issues. Pete Riley is now the de facto fire chief on the island and has all appropriate qualifications. 80% – 90% of his calls are medically related, and he has the option of remaining in his current residence after the lease ends in December. All Fire Department needs are currently being covered by the funds available to the Fire Department.

The county has still not approved our LGI zoning ordinance, as it is part of their Comprehensive Plan. The terms of office of Don Oleson, Carolyn DuPree and Bob Hill end in January. Don and Carolyn represent specific organizations and need to discuss reappointment with them. Bob is a member at large and indicated he will seek reappointment for one more term. Our next meeting is scheduled for 1:00 at Cedar point on December 10.
