Minutes of December 14, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 1 PM by Chairman Bob Hill.

Members present were Bob Hill, Paul Holmes, Barry Hurt, Dan Butler, Don Oleson and Carolyn Dupree.

Ed Vetter was introduced as the new representative for Gaspar's Hideaway replacing Don Oleson when his term expires Jan. 22, 2013 Carolyn Dupree's term expires in January also and she will be replaced by Frank Burger for the Hideaway Condo owners association.

Under old business the discussion on the DEP-Dock negotiations centered on the fact that we have had no official communication since October, but have had some unofficial information but nothing we can act on.

The "upland interest issue" for property owners who use a dock at the end of a platted street is still unresolved and seems to be the last major sticking point at this time.

Discussion concerning the lack of any progress toward getting the "LGI" zoning overlay accepted by the County Commission centered around the ongoing work on other parts of a comprehensive plan and staff does not feel they should ask our plan (completed four years ago) should be done before the rest of the /county is completed.

Mr. Hurt made a motion, seconded by Paul Holmes, to ask Mr. Quick to agree to ask the County Commission to accept our new ordinance since it has been hanging so long and has already been formatted into the new county plan style. Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Hill said he would get a meeting with Dan Quick and present our request.
