

## Minutes of Little Gasparilla Island Advisory Committee

Minutes of March 8, 2013

There were no minutes from the February meeting due to lack of a quorum. Potential new members Ed Vetter representing Gaspar's Hideaway and Tom Braakman representing Placida Beach Club had not been officially appointed at that time. Both have now been appointed and are official members.

Chairman Bob Hill announced that today all board members are present and we had a quorum. Bob reported on a meeting of the Dock Group with Deputy Director Al Dougherty and staff members, along with Jim Boxold, legislative liaison for Adam Putnam, State Secretary of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The meeting was held February 18, at DEP Headquarters in Tallahassee.

The main discussion centered on resolving the upland interest issue which was satisfactorily worked out, and how to set up ways to expand private easement and public easement (platted streets) docks. This issue was discussed at length with no resolution. This issue is ongoing and probably will not have agreement until after the Legislative session is over (early May) and perhaps not then. Efforts are ongoing.

The chairman reported that the schedule for presenting the new LGI zoning plan is as follows:

### Hearing at Planning and Zoning Board

1. Planning and Zoning Board, April 8, 1:30
2. 1st hearing County Commission, May 14, 2:00
3. Final hearing, County Commission, June 11, 2:00

There was a general discussion as to whether the new zoning ordinance will allow Yacht Clubs. The answer was not clear. Mr. Hill will follow up and report at the next meeting.

Next meeting will be April 12, 2013 at Cedar Point.
