Project Location: Located on FDOT right of way at the foot of US41 north bound bridge in the Charlotte Harbor CRA.

Estimated Completion Date: Last quarter 2018

Purpose of Funding Requested: Harbor Walk Phase 1B

Design Plans are 60% and being reviewed by FDOT. This phase of the project will include the fishing pier, water taxi/boat dockage and raised boardwalk to connect the east and west sides of US41.

If permits are required, list each required, it's type and status. Attach all permits that have been issued to this application along with the estimated length of time to complete the project by phase and a vicinity map.

Permits required: Permit application process will begin once the 60% plans have been reviewed by FDOT. We anticipate construction to begin Spring of 2017 and construction to be completed by the last quarter of 2018.

Benefit to the County: Provides improved access to the waterfront including a fishing pier and provides a temporary dockage for boaters to disembark and enjoy the amenities at the Harbor Walk. Water Taxi stop would also be available to bring visitors and residents between downtown Punta Gorda and Charlotte Harbor.

Any operating costs associated with the project: Anticipated total operating costs associated with the Harbor Walk project (Both Phase 1 and 2) after completion is \$65,000.

Other justification: The Harbor Walk will be the gateway into Charlotte County from downtown Punta Gorda and once completed is expected to be a catalyst for private investment into the area.




