Proposed are to replace 140 signs that are too small or faded; replace 34 pilings that are too short or badly weathered; and to add 23 piling to separate regulatory signs from markers.







The City of Punta Gorda must provide for the enforcement of its ordinance which establishes the approved boat speed restricted zone.*
6. All uniform waterway marker(s) authorized under this permit must be maintained in proper condition at all times. The City of Punta Gorda must immediately report and correct any discrepancies of any marker(s) to this office by calling during normal working hours at 904-488-5600, extension 36, or by facsimile at 904-487-4590.
7. Permit number 97-006 does not authorize the invasion of private rights, nor grant any exclusive privileges, nor does it obviate the necessity of complying with any other state, federal, or local laws and regulations.
8. By accepting permit number 97-006 and placement of the uniform waterway marker(s), the City of Punta Gorda does hereby, to the extent authorized by law, agree and promise to hold harmless the State of Florida, its employees, agents or successors, from fault with respect to any claim or claims arising from alleged negligence in the placement, maintenance, operation, and removal of any and all marker(s) placed by the City of Punta Gorda pursuant to this permit. The City of Punta Gorda further agrees to indemnify the State of Florida for any and all legal fees and costs incurred in defense of any suit brought against the State as a result of alleged negligence by the City of Punta Gorda in the placement, maintenance, operation, or removal of the uniform waterway marker(s).
9. *Violation of any provision of the permit shall result in the revocation of the authorization to place uniform waterway markers in, on, or above the waters of this state.*


