## **PUNTA GORDA BOATERS ALLIANCE**

The late Punta Gorda City Councilman, Dr. Dave Phelen, who saw the need for an organization representing the entire marine and boating industry in Punta Gorda, founded Punta Gorda Boaters Alliance (PGBA) in March of 2005. PGBA membership includes all of the major area cruise, boat, yacht and sailing clubs, University of Florida Sea Grant, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, the Peace River Sail and Power Squadron (PRS&PC), City of Punta Gorda, area marinas and most marine oriented businesses in the Punta Gorda area. At present count PGBA represents over 30 groups and 3000 members making it the largest marine oriented group in the County. PGBA safety programs: the "Captains Challenge" encourages all member and non-member boaters to complete U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary or U.S. Power Squadron boater safety courses, and annual "Vessel Safety Checks" performed by U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary or PRS&PS qualified Vessel Safety Examiners. They inspect member and non-member vessels annually and issue a decal signifying that the vessel conforms to Coast Guard regulations. In 2009, PGBA's award winning "Keep a Clear Head" program was launched at area marinas and yacht clubs where reward cards are issued to boat operators when they avail themselves of their pump-out facilities. While this program was well received and is still in existence the recent addition of the free pump-out boat, funded by the State and the County Marine Advisory Committee is a welcome addition, operating in the entire northern portion of the harbor. The "Keep a Clean Canal" program coordinates clean-up teams to clear the Punta Gorda and Burnt Store Isles canals of debris hazardous to the environment, damage to watercraft and safe boating. The Alliance has also designed, produces and distributes the "Boaters Alert Card" which lists the respective law enforcement agency phone numbers needed for on-the-water situations. They are distributed at no cost to boaters by marinas and law enforcement groups.

All of the programs are free except for a minimal fee for the Boaters Safety courses if taken in the classroom. Also, the Alliance is monitoring any proposed legislation that may impact boaters, such ethanol and boat ramp regulations. PGBA is presently pursuing a Waterfront Activities Center which would serve to

welcome boaters in the anchoring area, house several clubs and provide additional launching facilities for small boats.

The Alliance is currently re-designing their website ([Boat2puntagorda.com](http://Boat2puntagorda.com)) which in addition to its present information will include "real time" harbor activities such as regattas, boat shows etc. The site presently includes local navigation tips, provisioning and emergency facilities as well as links to area Yacht Clubs, local government sites, and historical areas of interest.

PGBA is a 501-(c)(4) organization supported by grants, donations, website advertising and membership dues. PGBA meetings are held at 9:00 AM on the third Thursday of the month at the Punta Gorda Civic Association building on Shreve St. in Punta Gorda. These meetings are open to the public.
