CURRENTLY IN CONSTRUCTION

Veterans Memorial Park

- On track for early delivery. Ribbon cutting ~ Feb 2017.

Harbor Walk Gateway Park (phase 2)

- Land acquired. Housekeeping in progress.
- Boardwalk* (phase 1b) awaiting permits. Start ~ spring 2017.

* Boardwalk funded through FDOT grants (not Sales Tax Program).

SCOPE

Design and Construct new Library and Archives.

ACQUISITION

- CM at Risk process (onboard)
- Budget \$6,901,000 •

MILESTONES

- Extensive public workshops conducted
- Substantial design review and consideration performed. •
- "Baseline" design vs. "Enhanced" design •
- Seeking BCC direction on design considerations •

DESIGN

Mission Revival style within historical context of Punta Gorda



Seeking BCC direction on design considerations

- <u>Baseline</u> design achieves program and code requirements; within budget \$6.9M.
- Enhanced design provides exterior arcades, entry plaza and awnings; requires + \$500k.
 - Functional additions, Edifice, ROI
 - Strong support from City and public outreach efforts
 - State Library Construction Grant request





Family Services Center Expansion and Renovations



SCOPE

- Perform Spatial/Functional Analysis
- Services will drive design

ACQUISITION

- Hard Bid Construction
- Budget \$5,995,000

MILESTONES

- Demolition of Peace Lutheran property expected ~ Jan 2017.
- Development of Campus plan expected to begin ~ May 2017.



Public Safety Projects

IN DESIGN:

West County Annex Replacement

 CM is on board.
 Design completion expected May 2017.
 Preliminary cost per SF are in budget.
 Construction start expected for Nov 2017.
 - concurrent with operations







Public Safety Projects

IN CONSTRUCTION:

- Fiber to Fire Stations
 - FS#4; Expected completion by Spring 2017
- Public Safety Digital Radio System
 - Ongoing system acquisition and design
- Sheriff District 1 HQ (West County)
- Jail Expansion Medical Wing

Sheriff District 1 Headquarters (West County)



SCOPE

 Design and Construct 12,000 SF building to support Sheriff's district-level administration and local operations.

ACQUISITION

- CM at Risk. GMP is set.
- Total project cost is \$4.35M
 - Program \$4.1M + Public Safety Fund \$250k

MILESTONES

- Construction in progress
- Completion expected Oct 2017.

Jail Expansion – Medical Wing



SCOPE

- Design and Construct Medical Wing.
- 3-floors: Clinic, Medical, and Mental Health

ACQUISITION

- CM at Risk. GMP is set.
- Total project cost is \$9.49M
 - Program \$9.1M + Public Safety Fund \$380k

MILESTONES

- In construction
- Expected occupancy Apr 2018

- North Charlotte Regional Park Aquatic Center
- Justice Center Generator Upgrade

- Program Expectations
 - Performance: schedule and budget
 - Accountability: all details/decisions are challenged
 - Transparency: project updates posted on County website
 - Engagement: abundant public input sessions
- Revenues currently exceeding projections (+25%)
- Construction and Building Costs
 8-10% increase from 2013 estimates
- Program is healthy. Projects have good momentum.
