

CHARLOTTE COUNTY LOCAL LICENSE UPDATE

Pursuant to <u>HOUSE BILL 735</u>, Charlotte County certificates of competency for local specialty licenses will sunset July 1, 2023. See conversion table below for future requirements starting July of 2023.

Charlotte County License Type	New License Requirements
Acoustical and Insulation	A license will no longer be required.
Aluminum Contractor	This license can be converted to a registered local specialty structure license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 and Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.015.
Asphalt Paving and Coating	A license will no longer be required.
Building Demolition Contractors (non-explosive)	This license can be converted to a registered local specialty license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 and Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.038.
Building Movers	Certified or Registered General, Building, Residential Contractor
Cabinet and Trim Carpentry	A license will no longer be required except for soffit and facia which will require a certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Specialty Structure (Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.015).
Carpentry License	A license will no longer be required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires a certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Specialty Structure (Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.015)
Ceramic Tile, Terrazzo, and Marble	A license will no longer be required.
Concrete Place and Finish	A license will no longer be required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires a certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Specialty Contractor.
Concrete/Masonry Contractors	A license will no longer be required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires a certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Specialty Contractor.
Door, Window, and Garage Door	This license can be converted to a registered local specialty license (Glass and Glazing) in accordance with F.S. 489.117 and Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.018.
Drywall	This license can be converted to a registered specialty license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 and Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.017.
Fence Contractor	A license will no longer be required.
Glass and Glazing	This license can be converted to a registered specialty license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 & Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.018.
Grade, Fill and Clear	Certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Underground Utility and Excavation contractor.
Job Site Clean-up	A license will no longer be required.
Commercial Landscaping	A license will no longer be required.
Lawn Irrigation	This license can be converted to a registered specialty license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 & Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.035.
Marine Construction	This license can be converted to a registered specialty license in accordance with F.S. 489.117 & Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.033.
Painting	A license will no longer be required.
Pile Driving	Certified or registered General, Building, Residential or Specialty Marine Contractor. (Florida Administrative Code 61G4-15.033).
Plaster, Stucco, and Spraycrete	The license will no longer be required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires a certified or registered General, Building, or Residential Contractor.
Shed Tie Down	Certified or registered General, Building or Residential Contractor unless exempt under F.S. 489.103.
Swimming Pool Shell	Certified or registered Commercial, Residential Pool/Spa Contractor or state specialty contractor.
Sign Contractor (non electric)	Certified or registered General, Building Contractor.
Structural Steel	Certified or registered General, Building or Residential Contractor.
Swimming Pool/Spa Water Treatment	A license will no longer be required.
