RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 380.06, FLORIDA STATUTES, AMENDING THE DEVELOPMENT ORDER (DO) FOR THE RIVERWOOD DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT (DRI) INCREMENT TWO TO EXTEND THE BUILDOUT DATE TO NOVEMBER 2025: FOR PROPERTY LOCATED 11. GENERALLY EAST OF THE MYAKKA RIVER AND NORTH OF S.R. 776 (SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST), CONTAINING 309 ACRES MORE OR LESS, IN THE EL JOBEAN AREA OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY; COMMISSION DISTRICT IV: PETITION NOPC-17-12-45; APPLICANT: RIVERWOOD COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on Januay 9, 1997, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") adopted Resolution 97-0030AO, approving a development known as Riverwood Development of Regional Impact Increment Two; and

WHEREAS, there have been several amendments to the Increment Two Development Order (DO) since the Board's initial adoption; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2004, the Board adopted Resolution Number 2004-256 to revise Map H, to require a biannual report instead of an annual report, and to extend the buildout date; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2011, the Board adopted Resolution 2011-023 to extend the buildout date of the Increment Two DO to January 8, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2012, the Board adopted Resolution 2012-024 to extend the buildout date of the Increment Two DO to November 11, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Riverwood Increment Two DO buildout date of November 11, 2016 has expired; and

WHEREAS, the buildout date of the Riverwood Increment Two DRI Development Order must be extended to allow the property owners within the DRI to apply for site plan and building permit review for expansion of their Activity Center; and

WHEREAS, the Riverwood Community Development District has requested an amendment to the buildout date of the Riverwood Increment Two DO be considered by the Board; and

WHEREAS, section 380.06(19)(c), Fla. Stat., provides that "[a]n extension of the date of buildout of a development, or any phase thereof, by more than 7 years is presumed to create a substantial deviation subject to further development-of-regional-impact review"; and

WHEREAS, section 380.06(19)(c)1, Fla. Stat., provides that "[a]n extension of the date of buildout, or any phase thereof, of more than 5 years but not more than 7 years is presumed not to create a substantial deviation; ...[t]he extension of the date of buildout of an areawide development of regional impact by more than 5 years but less than 10 years is presumed not to create a substantial deviation; ...[t]hese presumptions may be rebutted by clear and convincing evidence at the public hearing held by the local government; and, [a]n extension of 5 years or less is not a substantial deviation"; and

WHEREAS, the Riverwood Community District has provided clear and convincing evidence that their request does not constitute a substantial deviation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the amendments requested by the Riverwood Community District and finds that, pursuant to Chapter 380.06(19)(c), Fla. Stat., it does not constitute a substantial deviation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida:

- Resolution 2012-024 is hereby amended to extend the buildout date of the Riverwood Increment Two Development Order to November 11, 2025.
- This Resolution shall become effective as provided by law. County 2. Staff is hereby directed to forward a copy of the certified Resolution to the Department of Economic Opportunity, Division of Community Development, 107 East Madison Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, and to the Executive Director, Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council.
