SITE ANALYSIS

CONSTRAINTS


- Limited vehicular access
- Limited adjacent pedestrian / bicycle infrastructure
- Wetland/Mangrove areas
- Invasive species and limited environmental value
- Low elevation - no structures below 8'
- Size/location restricts large recreation gatherings



SITE ANALYSIS

OPPORTUNITIES

- Existing entrances/ circulation on site
- Close to proposed Sun Trail and sidewalks
- Existing entrances to site
- Existing river access
- Primary roadway entrances
- Connection to Myakka River Blueways



PROGRAM ELEMENTS

The park is identified as an environmental area designated for local community and recreation amenities such as trails, picnic areas, and connections to the Myakka River. Program recommendations originate from the site analysis and Parks and Recreation Master Plan
