for all sports camps is an additional \$15 per child, per week.

## Kids Camp Scholarship

This is a 50% scholarship that covers traditional or specialty summer camps only. Applicants must be Charlotte County residents and be employed over 20 hours per week or in school at least part time. There is required documentation that must be submitted along with the scholarship application. Money awarded to those who qualify on a first come, first served basis. Those awarded scholarship can also participate in the payment plan. Applications are available at South County Regional Park in Punta Gorda and Ann & Chuck Dever Regional Park in Englewood. Applications must be returned to one of these locations when completed. Applications available now but cannot be turned in prior to March 21. Only completed packets will be accepted.
