Separate storm debris into the SIX CATEGORIES shown here.

## NORMAL HOUSEHOLD TRASH

Normal household waste, recyclables and bagged debris of any kind will **NOT** be collected with storm debris. You should continue to follow your normal garbage removal schedule.



## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

DO NOT PUT OUT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE CURBSIDE (PAINT, CLEANERS, PESTICIDES, ETC.)





## NO PICKUP ZONE

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will **NOT** be picked up.

**DO NOT STACK OR LEAN!**  
Place all trash in an accessible area away from parked cars, fences, fire hydrants, mailboxes, trees, poles, power lines,

**DO NOT PLACE BAGGED DEBRIS CURBSIDE**  
Do not put bagged debris out for pick-up. It cannot be collected. Please note that only loose debris will be collected.
