

SEPARATING STORM DEBRIS



NORMAL Household trash

Normal household waste, recyclables and bagged debris of any kind will NOT be collected with storm debris. You should continue to follow your normal garbage removal schedule.

Separate storm debris into the SIX CATEGORIES shown here.

DO NOT PUT OUT

(DO NOT PUT IN BAGS)

ELECTRONIC WASTE

DO NOT **PUT OUT COMPUTERS** OFFICE **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT TELEVISIONS**

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS

DRYWALL FENCING FIXTURES FURNISHINGS GLASS METAL ROOFING MATERIALS TILE ETC.



NO PICKUP ZONE

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will **NOT** be picked up.



AIR CONDITIONERS **FREEZERS OVEN** REFRIGERATORS **STOVES WASHERS DRYERS** WATER HEATERS ETC.



Place all trash in an accessible area away from parked cars, fences, fire hydrants, mailboxes, trees, poles, power lines



MDO NOT PLACE BAGGED DEBRIS CURBSIDE

Do not put bagged debris out for pick-up. It cannot be collected. Please note that only loose debris will be collected.
