Call to Order / Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was present.

Changes to the Agenda / Motion to Approve Changes:

None

Citizen Input on Agenda Items Only (3 Minute Limit):

- Mr. Burkhouse commented on the marine marker relocation project, stated 34A is too close to his dock and requested the public be notified in advance of a project.
- Mr. Schoenhen states boaters are not following the slow speed/minimum wake sign and is interested to see what can be done to slow boaters down.

Approval of Minutes:

The minutes from March 17, 2022, were unanimously approved as submitted.

Unfinished Business:

- a. Manchester Waterway Dredge Project: Atkins Engineering was selected for the design & engineering of the dredge project; Mr. Patchell noted the proposed fee for services is \$108,800. Discussion ensued regarding adding the construction layout under the engineering firm's scope of work, Mr. Patchell noted this would be an additional \$28,200. Conversation followed regarding adding a spot dredge on the Manchester Waterway near the Indianapolis Waterway to the project; it would cost an additional \$23,850 for engineering services. Ms. McDonald noted to remain at approximately 15% reserves, the MSBU cannot expend more than an additional \$114,000 total for the Manchester spot dredge. Mr. Peck inquired on widening the channel at the s-bend of the Manchester Waterway extension, but it would be considered a new dredge and require a longer permitting process. It can be considered in the future. Mr. Mann motioned to add the spot dredge of the Manchester Waterway at the end of the Indianapolis Waterway, seconded by Mr. Peregoy. Discussion ensued regarding a cap to the budget for this additional location, the Chair called for a vote on the question, and it was unanimously approved. Ms. Bauer motioned to keep construction layout on Atkin's, seconded by Mr. Whims and unanimously approved.
- b. <u>Additional Slow Speed/ Minimum Wake Signage:</u> A regulatory slow speed/minimum wake sign cannot be installed on a navigational marker piling. If the Advisory Board would like to install additional signage it will require a permit application from the regulatory agencies and

- permit approval is not guaranteed. Ms. McDonald noted because this would be above and beyond what is required by law, the cost for materials and installation may be funded through the MSBU at an estimated \$2,500-2,800 per sign. Discussion ensued regarding enforcement issues, the effectiveness of signage and funding availability. The Chair requested consensus to table until after costs are received for dredging; Mr. Peregoy motioned to table, seconded by Ms. Bauer, and unanimously adopted.
- c. Marine Marker Relocation Project: GPS coordinates and pilings were inspected post-relocation and installation, 1 piling was reinforced. Ms. McDonald noted Public Works will not relocate pilings as they are not impacting access to private docks. Conversation followed regarding Marker 34 being relocated 40FT southeast to the property line as they believe it will still prevent vessels from running aground where the channel jogs. Ms. McDonald will confirm the feasibility of relocation.

New Business:

- a. <u>Future Navigational Trimming:</u> Photos submitted by the property owner on Flamingo Boulevard were reviewed, but at this time the vegetation is not causing a navigational hazard or line of site issue and the Advisory Board agreed not to take action.
- b. Financial Reports: The FY22 second quarter financial reports were reviewed.

Citizen Input on MSBU Items (3 Minute Limit):

- Mr. Anlauf commented on the recurrence of slow speed/minimum wake discussions at the
 Advisory Board level, has spoken with the Marine Unit of the Charlotte County Sherriff's
 Office regarding attending a Marine Advisory Committee (MAC) meeting to request funds for
 an additional vessel and establishing a volunteer patrol to educate boaters in all of Charlotte
 County. He agrees additional signage won't address the speeding issues.
- Mr. Schoenhen thanked the Advisory Board for their deliberation, agrees additional signage is not the answer and more public education is required.
- Mr. Burkhouse suggested if the Advisory Board wants additional slow speed signage to look into using the Blueway Waterway signs near markers 27, 31 and 33.

Advisory Board Open Discussion:

Conversation ensued regarding the feasibility of using the Blueway Waterway signs for additional regulatory signs, Mr. Patchell inquired about possible requirements for pole size and Ms. McDonald noted possible conflicts if not a Public Works asset and if the regulatory agencies would permit slow speed signage on these types of poles. Discussion ensued regarding public education for Charlotte County waterways and slow speed/minimum wake clarification.
