RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to the provisions of Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, has the power to establish, merge or abolish municipal service benefit units and levy and collect assessments within such units; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to reorganize and remove certain property from the South Burnt Store Street and Drainage Unit so that it may be added to the Burnt Store Village Street and Drainage Unit and to the proposed Pirate Harbor Street and Drainage Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the removal of property from the South Burnt Store Street and Drainage Unit is for a valid public purpose and in the best interest of the residents of the affected Units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida:

Section 1. Section 4-6-632 of the Charlotte County Code is amended as follows by providing for an amended territory and new description (map) of the Unit, attached hereto as Attachment 1, which depicts the property to be removed from the Unit (underlined sections are additions and strikethrough sections are deletions):

"Sec. 4-6-632. Territory.

The territory included within the unit shall include the portions of the unincorporated area of Charlotte County as depicted on the map attached to Ordinance No. 2005-032, § 1, 4-16-05 2010-011 as Attachment 1, and as more fully described in any assessment roll provided for in this article."

Section 2. Inclusion in the Charlotte County Code. It is the intention of the board of 1 county commissioners and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall 2 become and be made a part of the Code of Laws and Ordinances, Charlotte County, 3 Florida, and the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such 4 intention. 5 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or 7 applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or 8 applications. To this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable. 9 Section 4. Effective Date. 

ECONOMIC IMPACT ESTIMATE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XXIX, CHAPTER 4-6, OF THE CHARLOTTE COUNTY CODE; AMENDING THE SOUTH BURNT STORE STREET AND DRAINAGE UNIT BY PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY FROM THE UNIT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CHARLOTTE COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
