



# Local Option Sales Tax Projects

List of projects to be funded by the 2020 sales tax, if approved by voters

Charlotte County voters have approved five local option sales tax referendums since 1994. These pennies (more than \$430,000,000) have provided funding for more than 90 projects.

Utilizing sales tax funds spreads the cost of these projects among residents, seasonal visitors and tourists.
