Please be advised that starting in early May, Charlotte County Utilities' (CCU) Contractor, Poole & Kent will begin construction on a vacuum collection station. This is part of the centralized sewer construction coming to your neighborhood. The work site is at the intersection of Azalea Avenue and Skylark Lane, southwest quadrant. You will see contractors working there normally from 7:00 am-5:00 pm Monday through Friday, as well as the occasional truck delivering necessary materials for the construction. Part of the project involves utilizing a dewatering pump. You may hear this machine in operation, as well as see standing water in the swales as it moves towards the storm water drain. This is normal.
