Call to Order/Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order at 1:02 p.m. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was established.

Changes to the Agenda:

Citizen Input on Agenda Items (3-Minute Limit):

Mr. Horner, a resident of Suncoast Waterway voiced his concerns on the current dredge needs stating that he is a charter captain, and his lively hood depends on being able to get in and out of the waterways. Channel markers are obsolete, and the last storm impacted where the channel originally was.

Unfinished Business:

- a. <u>Navigational Trimming:</u> Conversation ensued regarding permits for trimming, Mr. Logan discussed the process and the purpose of navigational trimming stating that it is for two boats to safely pass, and the shelf life of a navigational trimming project is 2-3 years. Ms. LeMaster will check on the possibility of doing a budget adjustment for 20,000 for navigational trimming.
- b. <u>Post Storm Survey</u>: Discussion ensued regarding the benefits of just hot spot areas vs. a survey of the entire system. Mr. Clark made a motion to request a budget adjustment of \$20,000 for fiscal year (FY) 2025. The motion was seconded by Mr. Ferguson and passed unanimously. The group agreed to discuss the purview of the survey spot survey vs. full survey at the next meeting.
- c. <u>Dredging</u>: The group discussed the benefits of doing a spot dredge vs. a full dredge, focusing on mean low water averages and past survey results. The group expressed a need to understand the budgeting process and the process of a dredge project based on budget tolerances and the options they would have to move forward with a future project, so they feel more comfortable deciding which route to take.
- d. <u>Signage:</u> Ms. LeMaster advised that if the group moves forward with a bathymetric survey, we can add sign placement coordinates to the purview of the survey.

- e. <u>Grant Subsidies:</u> Discussion ensued regarding county owned land and the possibility of gaining grant funding for a public boat ramp and the group was reminded to contact Community Services.
- f. <u>FY26/FY27 Work Program:</u> Ms. LeMaster advised that the FY26/27 work program has not yet been defined.

New Business:

a. <u>Financials:</u> The FY24 quarter three financials were reviewed as well as the FY25 adopted budget. The group requested more information regarding interest and investment earnings and how that varies by Municipal Service Benefit Units (MSBU's).
