Subdivisions on Bermont Rd.-

Nigel Morris wanted to bring to the attention of the committee, concerns about two subdivisions on Bermont Road in eastern Charlotte County. Access is via easements on sectional breakdown lines resulting in unpermitted wetland impacts when property owners construct access roads and/or attempt to develop their properties. In some cases this has resulted in enforcement action by the South Florida Water Management District or the Department of Environmental Protection including fines being levied by SFWMD or DEP and then people pulling out of building and farming.

Shaun Cullinan addressed concerns about people living in campers and noted that the AG exemption process does not give you a pass to do whatever you want, but if Code Enforcement can't see it or get to it, they can't do anything about it. The area is not developed out there.

Lindsay Harrington asked if looking up a property to purchase on GIS, the county could add an areal parcel caution notice that the property is a wetland. Or an insert be added to the tax bill if they decided to build on it.
