#### Call to Order / Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order at 2:03 p.m. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was established.

#### Approval of the Minutes:

The July 9, 2025, minutes were unanimously approved as written.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

<u>Update: Dredge Project:</u> Staff provided an update regarding post-storm dredging needs. A total of 9,427 cubic yards of material were identified in the post-storm survey. Estimated project costs are approximately \$2 million. FEMA reimbursement is anticipated at \$528,950.84. The County intends to combine the Alligator Creek project with Pirate Harbor Waterway dredging contracts to attract lower bids and reduce per-unit costs. Estimated unit costs range between \$130–\$160 per cubic yard, lower than earlier estimates of \$170 per cubic yard. An extensive 100-page post-storm engineering and assessment report was submitted to FEMA. Once FEMA pre-approval is received, the County will move forward with bidding and construction while awaiting reimbursement. Staff emphasized that if FEMA does not cover the full amount, the difference will need to be paid from MSBU reserves or other County funds. Board members discussed prior staffing turnover in project management and expressed optimism that with Michael Benjamin now assigned as Waterway Project Manager, the project will gain stability and progress more efficiently.

#### **New Business:**

a. <u>Financial Reports</u>: The fiscal year (FY) 2025 quarter three actual expenditure and activity maintenance reports were provided for review. The MSBU retains \$50,000 annually for navigational trimming; unspent funds revert to reserves. The current balance includes \$330,691 carried forward. Encumbrances of approximately \$22,761 and \$46,000 were noted, likely related to survey and engineering costs. Staff will confirm with Fiscal Services what these expenses were for. Board members discussed the FY26–27 planned budget. A final budget hearing is scheduled for September 23. It was noted that while assessment rates have been increased to ensure sufficient funding, adjustments may be possible in the future if dredging costs come down.

# Citizen Input on MSBU items (3 Minute Limit): None

#### **Advisory Board Open Discussion:**

- Board Chair reported on discussions with Sergeant Christopher McRae of the Charlotte
  County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol. Concerns were raised about reckless boating,
  speeding at the creek entrance, and congestion near the waterfront restaurant. Sergeant
  McRae expressed interest in conducting a safety study and increasing patrol presence
  using both deputies and volunteer units. The Board agreed to gather detailed incident
  information (times, locations, types of violations) to provide to the Sheriff's Office.
- The Board discussed the ongoing creation of a community survey to gather input on boating safety and traffic issues. Potential recipients include civic associations, local marinas, and businesses along Alligator Creek. It was emphasized that Board members may share information informally among themselves since the survey falls outside official MSBU business. The Board agreed to refine the draft survey and distribute it to stakeholders.
