**Call to Order / Roll Call:**

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was established.

**Approval of the Minutes:**

The September 17, 2025, minutes were unanimously approved as written.

**Unfinished Business:**

- a. Update: Dredge Project: Staff provided an extensive update on the dredge project, including storm-related sediment accumulation, FEMA claim status, total estimated project cost, and expected MSBU share after FEMA reimbursement. The board confirmed its intention to pursue a full dredge to -6 feet. Staff discussed delays in FEMA claim processing and the potential diminishing value of pre-storm bathymetric surveys. The board agreed to revisit the need for biennial surveys in later years. Potential spoil sites were discussed due to the loss of Vasco Street as a staging area. Board members suggested vacant parcels near the Riviera Bar & Grill.

**New Business:**

- a. Financial Reports: The fiscal year (FY) 26-27 Adopted budget was presented. The adopted budget reflects the \$78 assessment rate and projected dredge-related expenses. A 10-year financial projection is under development. Financials were accepted by general consent.

**Advisory Board Open Discussion:**

- A speed study conducted by Marine Patrol along Alligator Creek resulted in zero observed violations. Board members expressed that conditions fluctuate seasonally and appreciated continued monitoring. Resident contact lists are being compiled for future surveys.
- No current navigational trimming needs were identified. Trimming remains budgeted for FY26–27.

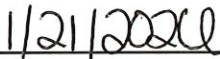
