Call to Order / Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was established.

Changes to the Agenda / Motion to Approve Changes:

None

Citizen Input on Agenda Items (3 Minute Limit):

Mr. Thompson expressed his interest in hearing the Sunrise Waterway dredge update.

Approval of the Minutes:

The August 28, 2024, minutes were unanimously approved as written.

Unfinished Business:

- a. Exterior Dredge Project: Mr. Nodine provided an update that Kelly Brothers started the project on September 5, 2024, and dredged about 450 feet before Hurricane Helene came through. Post Helene the contractor was pulled out of the Sunrise waterway due to the beach needing to be resurveyed. The contractor moved over to the Gardener Waterway and began dredging on October 16, 2024. Once Gardner Waterway is completed the contractor will move on to the George Waterway, and then finish up the Sunrise Waterway. The contractor is requesting a 20-day project extension due Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton. Mr. Nodine also pointed out that the dirt that was previously expected to be hauled to Tea Street to reuse for future beach renourishment projects was deemed unviable and is now being hauled to the landfill. Mr. Sousa had questions on if the dredge template will be re surveyed after the two recent hurricanes. Mr. Nodine assured the group that there will be another survey done.
- b. <u>Future Dredge Project Elkcam Waterway</u>, <u>Beeney Waterway</u>: The group decided to table this item at this time, with the intent to discuss at a future date.

New Business:

a. <u>Financial Reports</u>: The fiscal year (FY) 2025 Adopted Budget was provided for review. There were no questions at this time.

Citizen Input on MSBU items (3 Minute Limit):

Mr. Thompson had concerns regarding whether a boat with a 4–5-foot draft could navigate out of the channel safely. Mr. Nodine presented him with the most recent survey depths noting that he cannot make a recommendation at this time.

Advisory Board Open Discussion:

- Discussion ensued regarding the Municipal Services Benefit Units (MSBU's) responsibility for funding the maintenance of the Port Charlotte Beach Point. The group went on to discuss their belief that Community Services should be responsible for the park area encroaching into the channel, cleaning it up, and maintaining that area. Mr. Witzke made a motion to invite the following staff members to the next regular scheduled meeting to discuss the possibility for the County to hold financial responsibility for the maintenance and dredging of the Port Charlotte Beach Point: Director of Public Works, John Elias. Director of Community Services, Tommy Scott. Charlotte County Commissioner District 4, Stephen R. Deutsch. Legal Services Staff, and a Beaches and Shores Committee Member, and any other applicable staff pertaining to the decision making for that item. The motion was seconded by Mr. Kudrna and passed unanimously.
- The group discussed the procurement process and the possibility of exploring a five-year contract to fix prices on dredge projects. A copy of Florida Statute 189.4221 which allows special districts, municipalities, or counties to purchase goods and services from other local governments' purchasing agreements was distributed for record purposes and further consideration by legal and purchasing staff.
