Unfinished Business:

- a. <u>Update: Rampart Boulevard Sidewalk Project</u>: Ms. LeMaster provided an update that the survey has been completed and the information will be put into the 30% plans which will show the conceptual layout of the sidewalk and existing features with no grades on it yet. Once reviewed and comments are added they will address them and start working on the 60% plans. Once we have the approved 30% plans estimated for the end of February 2025 once received, she will share the 30% plans with the Advisory Board.
- b. Memorandum of Understanding (MOU): Ms. LeMaster updated the group that the MOU has been revised and is awaiting final signatures. The MOU is scheduled to go before the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) for approval during the January 14, 2025, meeting.
- c. <u>Canal Debris Removal</u>: Ms. LeMaster provided the most recent update received from Karen Bliss, Projects Manager, right now, the state Florida Department of Emergency Management (FDEM) is spearheading the waterway debris collection. We do not have a timeline and are currently working on pinpointing offload sites, etc. Ms. LeMaster provided the debris website advising for residents to report their waterway debris to www.Floridadebriscleanup.com.
- d. <u>Drainage Concerns</u>: Ms. LeMaster provided a list of open and closed drainage work orders to the group via email. The group discussed upcoming drainage with Mr. Prince and Mr. Altmeyer. Discussion ensued regarding work order timelines and outstanding work order

statuses. The group requested that drainage funding be moved to pipelining for drainage work that is unable to be accomplished during the fiscal year (FY).

New Business:

- a. <u>Financial Reports</u>: The FY24 quarter four actual expenditure report was reviewed. The FY24 quarter four monthly funding report (formerly maintenance activity report) were reviewed, as well as the FY25 Adopted Budget.
- b. <u>Sandhill Boulevard Sidewalk Project</u>: Ms. LeMaster advised that there is no update available at this time, she will provide an update once one becomes available.
