The February 22, 2024 minutes were unanimously approved as submitted.

Unfinished Business:

- a. <u>Bridge Maintenance Program</u>: Ms. Moneypenny advised that construction will begin June 3 on the shared Englewood East/Gulf Cove rehabilitations of bridges #014082 and #014088. Little traffic disruption is expected. The figure on the financial report reflects only the Englewood East portion; she will verify final cost. Purchasing is preparing the bid to repair and maintain the five other bridges: #014083, #014084, #014091, #014096, #01097. The board remarked that these are in good shape. If one were to fail, the MSBU would pay for repair.
- b. <u>FY25 Paving:</u> Mr. O'Rourke noted the MSBU has a good reserve for this project and no milling will be required. Ms. Moneypenny said Fiscal will present a budget, by December, with a set aside for projected cost and, if appropriate, borrowing options. The actual cost will be allocated in Spring 2025, when the bid is awarded. Mr. Gersch voiced concern about disruption to homeowners and advance communication of road closures. The board requested that the paving projects manager attend the next meeting.

Advisory Board Open Discussion: Mr. Gammel noted that Oyster Creek is choked with vegetation, and a foot higher than it was. Discussion ensued regarding tidal creeks in flood zones, creek navigability, intentional drainage delays, and the direction of water flow in Englewood East. While waterways are not under the purview of the MSBU, the creek may need

attention for purposes of drainage. Ms. Moneypenny said she would consult the appropriate experts in Public Works and invite that expert to the next meeting.
