The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Minutes: The Committee unanimously approved the April 2008 minutes as submitted.

Business:

- The Committee reviewed the Activity Report from January 1, 2008, through May 31, 2008.
- DEP has all the requested information about the S-curve project. They should be deeming the application complete shortly. Ms. Musselman will contact the City of Punta Gorda to see if they have any use for the sand that will be removed. If not, the spoil site will be the County property on Lister Street.
- There was discussion about docks being constructed in the easement and possibly blocking navigation. Mr. Mopps will investigate this. He said that DEP sends any questionable permits to him for review.
- Mr. Minzer stated that there is some blockage, possibly rocks in the center of the channel, about 20 yards above Marker 40. Mr. Mopps will investigate.
- Ms. Phelen asked about an update on the Riviera Marina. Ms. Musselman will contact DEP about this.
- The Committee requested that staff evaluate trimming the mangroves and any impediment to navigation at the easement.

The next scheduled meeting is Thursday, October 16, 2008, at 9:00 a.m. in the Public Works Conference Room, 7000 Florida Street, in Punta Gorda. Ms. Musselman will forward any updates received prior to the meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:58 a.m.
