ORDINANCE  
NUMBER 93-43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 93-24 TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE SOLICITING APPLICATIONS FOR POSITIONS ON THE ADVISORY BOARDS; AND TO ESTABLISH ADVISORY BOARDS FOR DEEP CREEK NON URBAN STREET AND DRAINAGE UNIT AND ALLIGATOR CREEK WATERWAY MAINTENANCE UNIT.

RECITALS

1. Section 2.2(H) of the Charlotte County Home Rule Charter specifies that the Board of County Commissioners shall, upon the petition of 30 or more electors residing in a unit, establish by ordinance an appointed Board of Advisors.

2. The Board of County Commissioners has received such petitions signed by more than 30 residents of the Deep Creek Non Urban Street and Drainage Unit and the Alligator Creek Waterway Maintenance Unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 93-24 is hereby amended as follows:

Upon receiving a signed petition from thirty or more electors residing within a unit, the Board of County Commissioners shall establish and appoint members to a Board of Advisors in accordance with the Home Rule Charter. A notice soliciting

applications for positions on the Board of Advisors shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation. The notice shall state the address to which all interested persons may apply and shall be published by the Office of County Administrator. However, failure to strictly comply with the publication requirements of the notice soliciting applications shall not invalidate the appointment of any Board of Advisors. The Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes a Board of Advisors for each of the units enumerated below:

- ~~1. Gulf Cove Street and Drainage Benefit Unit~~
- ~~2. Gulf Cove Waterway Maintenance Benefit Unit~~

Section 2. The following language is hereby added to Ordinance 93-24 as Section 2, and subsequent sections of Ordinance 93-24 are renumbered accordingly.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes a Board of Advisors for each of the units enumerated below:

1. Gulf Cove Street and Drainage Benefit Unit
2. Gulf Cove Waterway Maintenance Benefit Unit
3. Deep Creek Non Urban Street and Drainage Unit
4. Alligator Creek Waterway Maintenance Unit

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of the acknowledgment of its filing in the Office of Secretary of State, State of Florida.
