Business:

- The Committee reviewed the Activity Report.
- Ms Musselman reviewed the new proposed budget based on the outcome of the July 20, 2006, Public Hearing.
- Mr. Eiler presented pictures of the cul-de-sac on Goiana Street and the edge of pavement which was damaged, due to Waste Management. Mr. O'Kane noted that Waste Management will not go back to using the smaller trucks. We have tried to convince them, but with no avail.
- Mr. O'Kane explained the difference between the MSBU and Ad Valorem taxes.

Open Discussion:

- Issues with the POAs not being present at the meetings.
- Concerns that that MSBU Board had to endure the problems they have had. If residents were properly educated, this may not have happened.
