

MEETING MINUTES
DEEP CREEK STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
July 14, 2010
9:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order at 9:42 a.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the meeting held on March 30, 2010, were unanimously approved as submitted.

Business:

- Mr. Brown opened the Deep Creek Street & Drainage Meeting.
- The Committee discussed the one-cent sale tax, and why the citizens in Deep Creek voted in favor of the tax. The list at the time had areas in Deep Creek where sidewalks would be installed.
- There was discussion on a view of a methodology change of the MSBU's.
- Deep Creek has been receiving complaints on the conditions of the roads. The Committee discussed paving the roads in sections. The section maps that were given out a couple of year back, on when the paving was done on each road, are not accurate.
- Mr. Brown stated that we should have standards of maintenance on the roads and the county should maintain what needs to be done.
- The Committee is looking to cut cost on conducting Community meetings. Mrs. Harrison will check with Deep Creek School to see if the school would be available for a meeting. The Community meeting date will be held in October to give the citizens information on the paving plan.
- Mr. Biluk made a motion to have the pipes lined, unless Mr. Free finds that it would be more cost effective to replace the pipes. Mr. Lackie seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- There may be some pipes under homes and those pipes will be lined. Mr. Free discussed the competency of the contractor that was hired to line the pipes. The name of the company is Lando Lining. The Committee was given the web site for the Company.
- The locations where work is needed to be done are Deep Creek near Rio De Janiero and Copiapo.
- The Committee discussed how the sections will be divided to pave in Deep Creek. The Committee also discussed having the drainage work completed in the sections prior to paving. The paving is to start north of Sandhill. Mrs. Harrison and Mr. Free will get together on how the area will be divided and supply the information to the Committee for their approval.
- The Committee reviewed the activity report.

- Mrs. Harrison will meet with Mr. Free and Mr. Layport on details of the project.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:47 a.m.
