

**MEETING MINUTES**  
**DEEP CREEK STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**  
**October 21, 2010**  
**9.30 a.m.**

The meeting was called to order at 9:33 a.m.

**Minutes:** No minutes were presented to be approved.

**Business:**

- Mr. Brown opened the meeting for the Deep Creek Street & Drainage Advisory Committee. The topics of meeting items were announced.
- The Committee discussed holding a meeting to notify the Community of the details of the paving project.
- The Committee had discussion on how the trash is picking up and what vehicle is used. The issues on picking up the garbage and the damage to the roads and the turning radius for the trucks are set at 3. or 5. The Committee discussed how we can resolve the issues of the damage to the roads. At this time there was not resolution to the problem.
- There is 50 or 60 cul-de-sac in section twenty the statement was made the Community would not agree to have the green space in the center removed. The comment was made that there would be Utility conflicts in the cul-de-sac.
- The Committee may look at the roads that just end like Season Dr. they may want to add hammerheads at the end of the road.
- The roads were not built to handle the weight and the size of the garbage trucks and the cul-de-sac was not designed to have large trucks to make the turn.
- Waste management will offer a smaller container for citizens that are unable to move the larger ones.
- A motion was made by Mr. Smith not to include the Waste Management issues on the roads with the paving at this time. Seconded by Mr. Lackie all were in favor.
- A Community meeting needs to be held, the meeting will be held in November Wednesday or Thursday November 17, or 18 the time of the meeting will be set 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- Mr. Halfhill stated he would place two flashing signs indication the date for the Community meeting to be held.
- The Committee will meet again prior to the meeting with the Community to configure the presentation.

- The Committee discussed one of the members not attending the meetings a motion was made by Mr. Lackie to remove Mr. Palmer as member, due to lack of attendance seconded by Mr. Biluk all in favor.
- The Committee requested advertising for one regular member and one alternate member.
- The Committee discussed private roads and private complexes that impact the MSBU roads that do not pay into the districts. The Committee agrees that they should be paying.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:03 a.m.
