

**MEETING MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 10:35 a.m.

**Minutes:** Minutes were approved, as submitted, from the meeting held on March 29, 2010.

**Business:**

- The Committee discussed the Englewood East Homeowners Association Community meeting and the location of where they are held. The Committee briefed Mrs. Giblin on the sewer rights between Charlotte County and Englewood Water. The Homeowner Association is staying on top of the sewer situation.
- Some items on the Minutes, from the last meeting, were discussed--the pepper tree cutting and the bridge work done between Districts.
- Ms. Harrison explained the bridge inspections that are done by the State; these inspections are no longer public records due to safety issues. The Committee requested information on what needs to be done on the bridges in the Community. There are seven bridges located in Englewood East MSBU unit.
- The Committee discussed West County Stormwater Unit and what work is programmed in the future. The testing of the water is required by the Federal Government.

**New Business:**

- The Committee reviewed the Activity report. The Committee discussed drainage and line and grade work that is preformed.
- Sign maintenance was discussed. What kind of signs, the location of where the signs were replaced, and the signs that were installed for “No Six Wheels on the Road”. Mrs. Goblin stated the six wheel signs are not effective; the signs do not stop the trucks from using the roads.
- Mr. DeMello stated the police pulled over County trucks to make sure that they have work in the area.

- Mr. Pennypacker inquired why do we have over a million dollars we are carrying over when we have a loan to pay. Mr. Pennypacker is still concerned about having any carry over of funds. The Committee is looking forward to reducing the rate after the loan is paid.
- The Committee discussed the rates in other MSBU's districts and other taxes that support the County. The Committee talked about the project of the Mythology change of the MSBU structure. There was a meeting scheduled for the MSBU reorganization project and the meeting was cancelled.

Ms. Harrison will contact the Committee about scheduling the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:52 a.m.
