

MEETING MINUTES
ENGLEWOOD EAST STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
November 17, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 p.m.

Minutes: Minutes from March 31, 2011 were approved as submitted.

Old Business:

- The Committee discussed funding and paying off their loan early. They would like to reduce the life of their loan from eight years to seven years.
- Mr. Pennypacker made a motion to reduce the rate in 2013 from the previous rate of \$190.00 to \$95.00 for vacant and \$185.00 to \$85.00 for occupied ERU's. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lindberg with all members in favor.
- The Committee discussed the contractor responsible for cutting the pepper trees, and commented on what a professional job is being done.
- The Committee discussed litter clean-up within the community.
- The Committee requested information regarding bridge maintenance and inquired about the number of bridges within the district. Ms. Harrison will check with Mr. Free on the status and the number of bridges and will report her findings back to the Committee.
- There was discussion regarding the sidewalks and the responsibility of the district for funding. The citizens are not aware of the cost associated with sidewalk maintenance.

New Business:

Mr. Blais discussed the safety mowing contract with the Committee. He stated that if the right of way or swale areas are wet, the contractor will not enter those areas. The contractor mows in November, May, June, July and August. The contract is for safety mowing only not beautification. The contract was recently changed. South County is now covered by a separate contract and will no longer be mowed by the current contractor. The areas of the right of ways that have trees growing in them will not be mowed.

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- The Committee discussed specialty mowing, trash pickup and road sweeping. The comment was made that citizen participation in the community is diminishing. The Committee requested the cost of sweeping the roads.
- Mr. Blais emailed Ms. Harrison answers to questions regarding the work currently being performed. Mr. Blais supplied the Committee with an update for the mowing and back yard ditch clearing.

Ms. Harrison will contact the Committee at a later date to schedule the next meeting.
