

MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m.

Minutes: No minutes to approve

Business:

- Mr. Rathbun was presented with the 2006/07 and 2007/08 budgets, which were then discussed. Ms. Harrison explained that the 2007/08 budget was established based on the history of complaints and concerns from the residents.
- The Activity Report for October 2006 to the current date was reviewed, along with the work progress overview, which shows what was budgeted and how much was spent on each program.
- There was discussion about a dead-end sign that was hit some time ago and never replaced. Ms. Harrison will check with Jason Ouimet, Supervisor of the Signing and Marking Department.
- Ms. Harrison stated that 2007/08 will be the fourth year of payment on the ten-year paving loan.
- Ms. Harrison explained that, per State statute, five percent of collected revenue must be placed in reserve.
- A large area of sidewalk is broken at 13488 Isabel.
- Per Ms. Harrison, next year the roads will be rejuvenated, which will extend their life.
- Ms. Harrison discussed the MSBU study proposal, which is available online or at the Budget Office in the Murdock Administration Building.
- There was discussion about the canal that runs across to SR 776. It is located behind the clubhouse. Mr. DeMello advised that the box culvert is too small.

Open Floor:

- Residents who were present requested explanation of the MSBU's.
