Minutes: Minutes from the May 2, 2006 meeting were approved.

The Chairwoman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Unfinished Business:

- Status Report - Mr. DeMello provided an update on the work being done in Gulf Cove. Phases I, II and III of pipe installation is completed. Phases IV, V and VI are on the schedule to be completed in FY07. Additional drainage work is needed.
- Landscaping - Ms. Musselman suggested a joint meeting be held with the MSBU Committee, Officers of the POA, and the new Landscape Project Manager to discuss the landscaping needs. Ms. Kuhlman will schedule a meeting with Mr. Brown, POA.
- Mowing – The question was raised as to whether or not the County is responsible for mowing the cul-de-sac. Ms. Musselman and Mr. DeMello will research and get back to the Committee. Ms. Musselman advised the Committee that the new mowing bid will be priced two ways; 1) picking up the trash in the right-of-way and, 2) without trash pick up, to determine the difference in costs.
- Ditches – The Committee discussed the ditch on David from Latham to the lake. Mr. DeMello will have the Menzi Muck scheduled for October. He will also investigate the Committee's request to see if the ditch can be widened for easier maintenance.
