

MEETING MINUTES
GULF COVE STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
January 30, 2008
9:00 a.m.

Business:

- **Sunshine Law** - Assistant County Attorney Tom Rapp gave a brief presentation about the Sunshine Law and how it affects the Advisory Committee.
- **Paving** – There was discussion about paving the roads in Gulf Cove, which has been an ongoing issue. Mr. O’Kane advised that it is staff’s recommendation that all of the roads be repaved within the next three to five years. This idea has continually been rejected by the residents of Gulf Cove. Mr. Van Acker suggested that we pave only four main roads (Gillot, Foresman, David, and Jennings), which equate to 12.5 miles. This would allow all residents to have a newly paved road within one mile of their property. It would also form the two main loops, which make up the main access to the development. After more discussion on this option, Mr. O’Kane agreed that Public Works would come up with a cost estimate to do this work. The Advisory Committee and the residents in attendance agreed that it was a good start to getting the work done. Ms. Musselman will take the cost estimate and prepare an FY09 budget, not to exceed a \$75 rate increase.
- **Other Options** - There was discussion about the differences between reconstruction, repaving, and micro-resurfacing. There was also discussion about vegetation control on unoccupied roads. Public Works will come up with a list of the roads that can be completed with the above work.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:35 a.m.
