

MEETING MINUTES
GULF COVE STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
May 24, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 5:07 pm.

Minutes: The minutes of April 7, 2009, October 5, 2009, December 14, 2009, January 20, 2010 and April 15, 2010, were approved as submitted.

Business:

- Ms. Musselman reviewed the three paving scenarios submitted. Example one is all paving completed in one year with an 11 year borrowing schedule, the increase will be \$30 per year. Example two is a four year phased paving plan borrowing only two years, the increase will be \$103 for four years. Example three is no set borrowing, but how much money could be allocated to paving each year in the current budget, estimated to take 16 – 20 years to complete paving.
- The Committee discussed the different options given and the financing options. The proposed survey to be mailed to residents was reviewed. Suggested changes included adding the word “contract” prior to . . . the cost of \$7,100,000. Also, next to the total increases, add the year when the paving would be completed.

Open Floor:

- Resident’s comments varied during discussion.
 - Pave as we can and don’t pay any interest.
 - Worth the \$30 increase pave all the roads and we will save money on car repair.
 - The people who don’t want to pay do not live here all the time.
 - Pave all the roads at once it will increase property values.
 - What about swales, they need to be fixed first.
 - If you pave as you go, how would you pick the roads to be done first?

The meeting was adjourned at 6:56 p.m.
