

MEETING MINUTES
GULF COVE STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
November 30, 2011
4:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 4:44 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from December 29, 2010, February 3, 2011 and March 3, 2011 were approved as submitted.

Old Business:

- The Committee discussed the funding for the paving. No financial reports on the breakdown of the loan were previous provided.
 - Mr. Koons presented a map showing the conditions of the roads remaining to be paved. The map indicated the conditions of the roads as failed, poor, fair, and good. There are 50 miles of roads programmed to be paved. There are an additional 28 miles of roadway remaining to be paved, that are not yet programmed. Paving will commence in May 2012. The roads will be reevaluated early in February 2012. Depending on the price bids for the paving contract, additional roads may be paved. The County will look at removing roads from the paving project if no homes are present.
 - A motion was made, on the route the contractor should take during the paving construction. No second was forthcoming and the motion failed.
 -
 - Mr. Wozniak noted that the Advisory Committee should not mandate how the paving should be conducted. The Contractor provides a haul route to the County prior to commencement.
 -
 - It was noted that Tara Musselman and Dan Quick stated to the BCC that all the roads would be paved with the \$30.00 increase at the Public Hearing.
 -
 - A citizen asked about the cracking of the blacktop. Mr. Koon explained that if there is a concrete base under the blacktop, cracking would appear. Gulf Cove has concrete base under the roadways.
 - Several residents expressed concerns about drainage issues. Mr. Halfhill told them to contact him or Public Works to report their issues for investigation and scheduling.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:07 p.m.
