The meeting started at the Charlotte County Fair Grounds and proceeded with meeting Chuck Mopps, Matt Logan, and Jamie Cohlmeier in boats for a review of the waterways.

The meeting was established to check the depths of the waterways and the Marine Markers location.

**Business:**

- The three marine markers identified to be relocated are in the Venus Waterway. One Marine Marker was checked in the Apollo Waterway.
- The contractor that installed the markers will relocate the markers at no charge to the MSBU.
- The Apollo Waterway will be re-surveyed, after the completion of the project, to insure the depths meet the specification of the contract.
- Mr. Mopps was in the water, checking the depths of the waterway, at certain locations identified by citizens and Committee members as being shallow.
- The Committee members had a conversation on the marine markers, near the docks, on whether they should be removed or relocated.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:50 p.m.
