The meeting was called to order at 1:30 pm

Old Business:

Multi-purpose Pathway – Detailed discussion about the plans. Each member gave their thoughts and opinions. Mr. Peszko opened the discussion to the floor. Several residents commented on the project. After all comments were considered, Mr. Schermerhorn made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dodd, to proceed with the current pathway design with the following changes, all in favor. Motion Carries.

- The pathway is to be asphalt instead of concrete
- Elimination of the landscaping plans
- Elimination of the lighting plans
- Installation of 4 cabbage palms at each of the three benches.

Ms. Musselman will give this information to the design engineering and will forward the new plans and bid specs when she receives them. Ms. Musselman suggesting that the bid specs include the current lighting and landscaping plans as optional items this way the Committee has a true estimate of the cost in case they would like to install in the near future. It is estimated that with these changes the cost of the project will be around \$350,000.

The next meeting will be scheduled when staff has bid information to report.
