

**MEETING MINUTES**  
**SOUTH GULF COVE STREET & DRAINAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**  
**January 15, 2009**  
**9:00 a.m.**

**Attendees:** Jack Paine, Karen Ireland, Ron Bick, Lucille Consol, Tony Ermirio, Sandy Slater, Carmine Rossi

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

**Minutes:** No minutes were submitted for approval.

**Business:**

- Mr. Paine was reappointed Chairman, and Mr. Bick was reappointed Vice-Chairman.
- Mr. Paine will visit Waste Management regarding trash on roadsides.
- The Committee will review bridge issues--including what constitutes bridge inspection, and when clean-up and painting are scheduled to begin--with Ms. Musselman at the next meeting.
- There have been complaints from residents about vegetation trimming and brush removal. Questions were raised about when the work will be done, how much it will cost, and if there are other options to control pepper tree growth.
- The street signs that were requested have not been received.
- The Committee would like information about how much it would cost to add one mowing for major roads.
- There was significant discussion regarding money for beautification and how it would be treated in the 2009/10 budget. Mr. Paine said it would cost approximately \$5-6 million to repave South Gulf Cove. He reminded the Committee that it represents all South Gulf Cove property owners. The Committee voted (three in favor; one abstained) to consider putting less money in reserve for road paving in order to provide funding for beautification. Nothing will be decided until next year's budget items are reviewed.
- Mr. Paine wants to look into right-hand turn lanes.
- Ms. Consol will create a system to track all action items, including responsibility, date added, and date completed. Mr. Ermirio will document the process the Committee uses, and the Committee will send Ms. Consol any open action items.
