The meeting was called to order at 9:06 am

**Minutes:** Minutes of March 16, 2009, and May 18, 2009, were approved as submitted.

**Election of Officers:**

- Mr. Redican was unanimously elected Chairman and Mr. Bick was unanimously elected Vice-Chairman.

**Business:**

- Chara - Mr. Hunter gave an update on the Chara problem in SGC. The areas which were treated in January are as bad, if not worse now. Mr. Hunter recommends spot treatment for those areas with lifts and boats so they can get out. At this time he can dedicate a crew to work the canals in SGC for one day a week. They will be able to do and estimated 10 – 12 spots a day. Discussion on adding more Carp. Mr. Hunter stated that he would evaluate the Carp again in October giving them some more time to work. Mr. Bick made a motion, seconded by Mr. Giraldi, to purchase a minimum of 10,000 lbs of the Green Clean Pro so that it is on hand and we do not run out. Motion passed unanimously.
- Trout Creek Update - We are still waiting for the Army Corps permit. Estimate construction to start early fall.
- Signage - The new signs are being placed at the lock advising there is no fishing/netting/crabbing or any recreational activities in the lock area, including the docks.
- Fence - The PO is completed and the fence should be moved with the next week or so.
- Committee reviewed the FY11 Budget and financial reports.
