- **What is Geocaching?** An outdoor treasure hunt using GPS devices. Participants use GPS coordinates to find a geocache (container) hidden at a specific location.
  - Cache sizes may vary, but must contain a logbook or logsheet
  - May contain prizes/trade items

- **What is Questing?** A place-based, educational scavenger hunt with clues and questions designed to pass along knowledge about a location. Questing can cover small locations to large historic districts.

    1.
