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AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 163.3187 (1) (c), FLORIDA STATUTES, ADOPTING A SMALL SCALE AMENDMENT TO THE CHARLOTTE COUNTY FLUM SERIES MAP #1: 2030 FUTURE LAND USE, FROM AGRICULTURE (AG) TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (LDR), FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 29255 JONES LOOP ROAD, IN THE PUNTA GORDA AREA, CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, COMMISSION DISTRICT II, CONTAINING 9.53 ACRES MORE OR LESS; PETITION PA-14-04-09; APPLICANT, TMV PROPERTIES, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, in a public hearing held on Tuesday, July 22, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida ("Board"), reviewed land use amendment Petition PA-14-04-09, which is a small scale plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, applicant, TMV Properties, Inc. ("Applicant"), filed Petition PA-14-04-09, seeking a small scale plan amendment to the Charlotte County FLUM Series Map #1: 2030 Future Land Use, from Agriculture (AG) to Low Density Residential (LDR), for property containing 9.53 acres more or less, described as property located at 2925 Jones Loop Road, in the Punta Gorda area, Charlotte County, Florida, Commission District II, and more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Petition PA-14-04-09 has previously been heard before the Charlotte County Planning and Zoning Board ("P&Z Board") and, based on the findings and analysis presented in the Planning Division Staff Report dated May 23, 2014, has been recommended for approval by the P&Z Board; and






