Any passenger unable to care for all their needs must be accompanied by a caregiver who will ride free of charge.

No charge for children under 12 years of age and they must be accompanied by an adult.

All buses are equipped to carry bicycles.

## For Disadvantaged

Charlotte County Transit has a curb-to-curb service for individuals considered to be transportation disadvantaged. One may be considered transportation disadvantaged if he/she is disabled, 60 years of age or older, or is qualified as low-income or living in a rural area,

To apply for transportation disadvantaged service, call 941.575.4000 and request a transportation disadvantaged application. Once enrolled, passengers pay a \$1.00 co-pay, each way, for life sustaining trips.

  - To reserve rides originating in Englewood, dial 941.681.3796.

## How to Connect

Charlotte County Transit is safe, reliable and flexible transportation within Charlotte County. Call to reserve your ride 24 hours before your trip. Have your fare ready for the driver at time of pick-up. Exact change is required.

A courteous and competent driver will provide curb-to-curb service to and from your destination in Charlotte County.

Service area includes the Charlotte County portion of Englewood, Port Charlotte and Punta Gorda south to Tropical Gulf Acres, east to the airport and north to Peace River Shores.

## For a Smooth Connection

Charlotte County Transit is a trip by reservation service. It is not a bus-route operation like those in many metropolitan areas. Each day the driver has a different route and schedule to accommodate each passenger's travel plans.

We ask that you be understanding and flexible in pick-up times by allowing a 30 minute window from reservation times. Please allow one hour for travel and one hour at your destination.

We recommend making a reservation 24 hours in advance as we operate on a "first come, first served" basis. Trips may be arranged the day prior if space is available. All reservations must be made by 1:00 PM for the next business day. Reservations for Saturday and Monday must be made by 1:00 PM on Friday.

If your plans change, please be courteous and cancel your reservation.

## Connection Hours and Rates

Charlotte County Transit operates Monday thru Friday from 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM and on Saturdays from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM. There is no service on Sundays and nationally recognized Holidays. The reservation line is open from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.

One-way fare to any destination in the service area is \$3.00. Exact change is required. (Add \$1.00 to fare when crossing bridges over the Peace or Myakka Rivers.) A discount is given to passengers qualified as transportation disadvantaged.
