Participation	0	12	3



Trend Comparisons Over Time

- Dramatic improvement from 2007 to 2010 – (Best overall improvement nation-wide)
- Little statistically valid change from 2010 – 2012
- Little statistically valid change from 2012 - 2014
- However, In some areas there has been steady movement from 2010 - 2014

Quality of life	+9%	Overall direction	+11%
Ease of walking	+15%	Crime prevention	+17%
Health care	+20%	Value for taxes paid	+14%
Opportunities to participate	+13%	Recreation centers	-10%
